"Because I'm going to take pictures!" yelled the photographer. "I'm a photographer, and photographers take pictures."

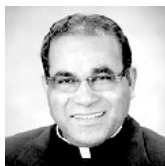
With an even more worried look on his face, the pilot replied, "You mean you're not the flight instructor?"
